

Milan Jakovljević

Milan was born in 1960 in the village of Mirosaljci, municipality of Lazarevac, in a family of miners. Upon completing electrical engineering high school in Lazarevac, he graduated from the Faculty of Mining and Geology in Belgrade.

He started his working career at the open cast mine Field "D". At the open cast mines in RB "Kolubara", Milan worked as shift manager, overburden and coal production manager, and as the mining technical preparation manager.

Mid-2001, he was transferred to PE EPS to the position of Assistant Director of the Coal Production Department. From 2002 to 2005, he worked as the Director of the Coal Production Department. Since the establishment of the Energy Generation Department in 2005, he was the Assistant Director for Coal Production. From 2012 to 2015, he worked as a coordinator for coal production and maintenance of mining capacities. From 2015 to 2021, he was Head of the Coal Production Technical Affairs Department in PE EPS. Since December 16th, 2021, he has been holding the position of the executive director for coal production technical affairs.

He is the author of several research papers in the field of surface coal mining and environmental protection. He has been EPS' representative in the European Association for Coal and Lignite EUROCOAL since its founding in 2002.
