In accordance with the Conclusion of the Government of the Republic of Serbia 05 No. 312-7738/2007-5, dated March 19, 2009, by which Information on concept of attracting strategic partner for the project of reconstruction of CHP Novi Sad is accepted, the joint stock company for cogeneration of thermoelectric power and heating energy "Energija Novi Sad" (hereinafter referred to: "ENS Novi Sad"), founded by the City of Novi Sad and the Public Enterprise „Electric Power Industry of Serbia“, Belgrade, hereby announces

PUBLIC INVITATION
TO INTERESTED PARTNERS FOR SUBMISSION OF LETTERS OF INTEREST AND PROOFS OF
FULFILMENT OF QUALIFICATION CRITERIA FOR INVESTING IN MODERNIZATION
AND EXTENSION OF CHP NOVI SAD

1. With the intention to secure economically and environmentally sustainable energy supply in the wider area of Novi Sad on a long term basis, the CITY OF NOVI SAD and PE "ELECTRIC POWER INDUSTRY OF SERBIA" have founded the ENS Novi Sad, in order to provide the framework for generation of electricity and heating energy and to create conditions for investment-oriented maintenance and development of capacities which are to increase reliability of generation facilities for electric power and heating energy.

The investment project involves construction of a modern unit for cogeneration of electric and heating energy in combined gas-steam cycle with installed electrical power in the range of 400-500 MW, with the plant being a base heat load and having the power of at least 300 MW for more than 80,000 households and commercial consumers in Novi Sad.

Within the process of capital increase of the ENS Novi Sad, the CITY OF NOVI SAD and PE "ELECTRIC POWER INDUSTRY OF SERBIA" will invest existing site with the complete infrastructure and generation facilities, and selected strategic partner is expected to obtain majority stake in ENS Novi Sad by capital increase. In addition to necessary financial and operating capacity experience in constructing and managing of similar facilities is required.

2. Interested participants are invited to submit a Letter of Interest for the participation in the tender procedure. The Letter of Interest should include general information about the interested participant: name, address and registered head office of the company, name, title, address, phone numbers, fax numbers as well as the e-mail address of the person responsible for dealing with all inquiries related to the qualification procedure. Only the Letters of Interest delivered by the deadline indicated shall be taken into consideration.

4. Instructions for preparation and submission of documentation for fulfilment of qualification criteria shall be given only to interested participants, whose letters have been submitted properly. It is expected that the qualification process will be completed in the last quarter of 2009. Interested participants fulfilling the qualification criteria will be invited to participate in the tender process and to submit the bid.

After Confidentiality Agreement is signed and tender documentation is purchased, site visits and access to data room will be granted to participants in the tender procedure for the preparation of binding bids.

5. This Public Invitation does not represent an obligation to qualify, choose or accept any of the interested participants. The Announcer of the Public Invitation reserves the exclusive right to make a decision on renouncement, discontinuance or termination of qualification procedure or tender procedure.
