Subject: additional clarifications no. 4 in accordance with Article 63 paragraph 3 of Public Procurement Law ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia" number 124/12) in an open public procurement procedure for the procurement of goods with the services "Information System to Support the Sale of Electricity", PP number 31/14/DIKT, for which Invitation to Tender was published on Public Procurement Portal on 20.06.2014.

Five and more days prior to expiry date foreseen for submission of tenders in subject public procurement procedure, interested party has submitted to the Employer via e-mail request for additional information, i.e. clarifications, regarding which the Employer, i.e. Public Procurement Committee, in accordance with provision of Article 54 paragraph 12 item 1) of the Law shall provide the following information i.e. clarifications within three days from the day of the receipt of the request:

Question 1: "Can a group of tenderers engage a subcontractor?"

Answer 1: Group of tenderers can engage a subcontractor.

Question 2: "If the answer to Q1 is YES, is there any limitation for such subcontractor? Of course, subcontractor would meet all condition stated in Tender documents, section 4.7.?"

Answer 2: All conditions from the tender documentation (**4.7 SUBCONTRACTORS, 4.8 GROUP OF TENDERERS (JOINT TENDER)**) should be met, and also Article: 80. and Article: 81. from the Law for Public Procurement.

Question 3: "If the answer to the Q1 is YES, can you please specify which option should we use when filling Form 2 (Tender Form)?"

Answer 3: You should use the option "joint tender" as shown in the table below.
