Subject: additional clarifications no. 49 in accordance with Article 63 paragraph 3 of Public Procurement Law ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia" number 124/12) in public procurement procedure PP number 61/14/DEFP, for which Invitation to Tender was published on Public Procurement Portal on 10.10.2014.

Five and more days prior to expiry date foreseen for submission of tenders in subject public procurement procedure, interested party has submitted to the Employer via e-mail request for additional information, i.e. clarifications, regarding which the Employer, i.e. Public Procurement Committee, in accordance with provision of Article 54 paragraph 12 item 1) of the Law shall provide the following information i.e. clarifications within three days from the day of the receipt of the request:

Potential Tenderer asked QUESTION No. 49.1:

"In Tender Documents at page 14 criteria for Contract award was listed and it was explained that the Employer ranks acceptable bids of the Bidder in portions (identical lots) so that at the list the best ranked portion is the one with the lowest price stated in the appropriate bid of the Bidder in item IV 17 of the filled in form 1 of the Tender Documents.

We would like to ask the Employer to answer the following questions:

- Do the Bidder when submitting a Bid apply for the exact portion of a certain number?
- Does in that case, if none of the Bidders apply for one/several portions, there could be a situation that under that portion/portions Bidders are not selected and therefore the Employer will not collected the required number of Bids?"

ANSWER of the Employer to QUESTION No. 49.1 is:

"No, the Bidder, when submitting a Bid, does not apply for a portion with a certain number.

In the Tender documents, it is stated that the *portions are not numerated*, since they are identical lots that are equal among each other (5 mili. euros).

The Bidder may **submit X Bids** (if it offers **X different** conditions **per portions**)

The Bidder submits 1 Bid for N portions (5 mili. euros) with same conditions.

In item IV 3 of Form no. 1 of the Tender documents the Bidder puts: Number of portions (identical lots) (N portions) for which it submits a Bid with identical conditions.

In item *IV 17 of Form no. 1* of the Tender documents the Bidder puts: "*The price offered* for the public procurement of loan in **portions** (identical lot) is determined as an aggregate of total costs (item 11 of the filled-in Form 4 of this Bid)"

The Employer at the same time ranks all acceptable Bids of all Bidders according to the offered price per portion shown in the Bids of the Bidders - filled in Form no. 1 (item IV 17).

The best placed portion on the list shall be the portion with the lowest offered price."

These additional clarifications are submitted by email to the applicant and are published on Public Procurement Portal and web site of the Employer.
