

Radovan Stanić

Radovan was born in 1967 in the city of Užice. He graduated from the University of Belgrade's School of Electrical Engineering in 1994. Immediately after graduating, he began his career in the Public Enterprise "Elektrodistribucija Užice" as an engineer for analysis and development of metering systems. Afterwards, he worked as the head of the Metering and Control Division, the head of the Electricity Procurement and Sale Department, and in 2001 he was appointed director of the Public Enterprise "Elektrodistribucija Užice". At the beginning of 2004, Radovan continued his career in Public Enterprise Electric Power Industry of Serbia, as the head of the Electricity Distribution Department.

As an exceptional expert in the fields of economic environment, laws and by-laws, Radovan has been intensively engaged in the preparation, formation and establishment of EPS Supply's operation. Ever since the company was founded in 2013, he was the head of the Public Procurement Department, and as of October 2017, he was appointed the head of Electricity Supply in PE EPS HQ. Radovan manages SAP billing development and implementation project, the first billing system that will uniformly process data based on which electricity bills are prepared, controlled and issued for all 3.5 million customers in Serbia.

Radovan was appointed PE EPS Executive Director of Electricity Supply Affairs on December 3rd, 2021.
